


The U.S. manufacturing sector contracted in June, as the Manufacturing PMI® registered 46 percent, 0.9 percentage point lower than the reading of 46.9 percent recorded in May. This is the eighth month of contraction and continuation of a downward trend that began in June 2022. That trend is reflected in the Manufacturing PMI®'s 12-month average falling to 48.8 percent. Of the five subindexes



that directly factor into the Manufacturing PMI®, none are in growth territory. Of the six biggest manufacturing industries, only one (Transportation Equipment) registered growth in June.




In May, the Services PMI® registered 50.3 percent, a 1.6-percentage point decrease compared to the April reading of 51.9 percent. 
Real GDP growth projections for 2023 and 2024





Workforce VC AI: Talent Acquisition

Paradox is an AI company that helps companies capture and screen candidates, improve conversions, and answer all candidate questions. They raised \$200M series C funding with the principal investor was Unilever, an enormous conglomerate that owns close to 500 brands and is indicative of a major shift in AI recruitment.

Eightfold.ai AI technology assists companies in recruiting, developing, and retaining top talent, reducing time and cost to hire significantly. They raised \$220M in a Series E funding round led by SoftBank's Vision Fund 2 in July 2023, reaching a valuation of \$2.1B.

SeekOut is an AI recruitment platform based in Washington. They provide companies a competitive edge in recruiting hard-to-find and diverse talent. They raised \$115M in January 2022 Series C financing.

AI VC\$: SmartBuildings

<u>Verdigris Technologies:</u> This company offers AI-powered energy management solutions for commercial buildings, enabling more sustainable and efficient operations. They recently raised \$17.7 million in a Series A funding round led by StartX.

Openpath: Focusing on smart access control, Openpath leverages AI to enhance security and user experience in commercial spaces. In a recent funding round, they raised \$36 million, led by Greycroft, with participation from Okta Ventures and LPC Ventures.

<u>Cohesion:</u> This smart building software provider is an information technology company that offers a vertically integrated smart building SaaS platform. They raised \$15 million in a Series A funding round.

AI VC\$: Cyber

<u>Deep Instinct:</u> This cybersecurity firm utilizes deep learning to predict and prevent cyber threats in real-time. In a recent funding round, they raised \$100 million, led by funds managed by BlackRock and Untitled Investments.

Cybeats Technologies: Cybeats SBOM Studio is an enterprise-class solution that helps you understand and track third-party components that are an integral part of your own software. They raised \$8 million in a post-IPO funding round.

QWERX: QWERX, Inc. is a software company that delivers secure, quantum-proof machine identity management and authentication to the enterprise. They recently raised \$1.7 million via angel investors and a convertible note.
