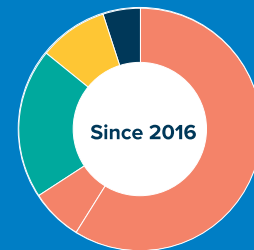
## → RELIABLE, LOW-COST POWER
