

MEAG Power Solar Initiative Fact Sheet



MEAG Power’s mission is to provide reliable, affordable power to our Participant communities. Over time, that power generation has increasingly come from emission-free sources. In fact, our Participants have access to some of the cleanest power in the Southeast – 65% emissions-free on average since 2016. That percentage could rise with the addition of the Pineview Solar Project, MEAG Power’s first solar initiative, as well as future solar facilities.

Pineview Solar Facts

- 80 MW facility in Wilcox County, Ga.
- 15-year power purchase agreement (PPA)
- COD expected by early 2026
- An estimated 260,000 solar modules covering 600 acres
- Is expected to produce enough energy to serve 15,000 households each year
- Will avoid an estimated 1.5 million tons of CO2 during the 15-year PPA
- Employs bifacial solar panels that capture sunlight on both sides, including light reflecting off the ground
- Racking systems adjust panel tilt to follow the sun’s track, maximizing energy production
